## 1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The **Pavel Roman Memorial** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2014, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules Ice Dancing 2014, the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the **Pavel Roman Memorial** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 2. b) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and the relevant ISU Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 1420 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. The passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must to be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation.

### World Standing Points

In case the requirements as per ISU Communication 1629 are fulfilled, World Standing points will be awarded in the category Senior Ice Dance.

### 2.2. Categories

#### 2.2.1. Senior Ice Dance

##### Short Dance

In accordance with the ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2014, Rule 709. Rhythms, required elements and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communication 1932 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 2 minutes and 50 seconds +/- 10 sec.

##### Free Dance

In accordance with the ISU Technical Rules Ice Dancing 2014, Rule 710. The required elements to be performed are those listed in ISU Communication 1932 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 4 minutes, +/- 10 seconds

#### 2.2.2. Junior Ice Dance

##### Short Dance

In accordance with the ISU technical Rules Ice Dancing 2014, Rule 709. Rhythms, required elements and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communication 1932 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 2 minutes and 50 seconds +/- 10 sec.

##### Free Dance

In accordance with the ISU technical Rules Ice Dancing 2014, Rule 710. The required elements to be performed are those listed in ISU Communication 1932 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec., +/- 10 seconds

### 2.2.3. Advanced Novice Ice Dance

#### Pattern Dances

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2014, Rules 707, 708 and all pertinent ISU Communications.

Two (2) Pattern Dances are to be skated:

Group 3: **#12 Kilian** and **#23 Blues**

Rhythms, required elements and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communications 1932 and 1947 and subsequent updates.

Couples **shall** provide their own music for the Blues

#### Free Dance

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2014, Rule 710 and all pertinent ISU Communications.

The required elements to be performed are those listed in ISU Communications 1932 and 1947 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 3 minutes, +/- 10 sec.

### 2.2.4. Basic Novice Ice Dance

#### Pattern Dances

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2014, Rules 707, 708 and all pertinent ISU Communications.

Two (2) Pattern Dances are to be skated:

**#1 Fourteenstep** and **#4 European Waltz**

Rhythms, required elements and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communications 1932 and 1947 and subsequent updates.

Couples **shall** provide their own music for the European Waltz

#### Free Dance

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2014, Rule 710 and all pertinent ISU Communications.

The required elements to be performed are those listed in ISU Communications 1932 and 1947 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 2 min., 30 sec., +/- 10 sec.

### 2.2.5. NON ISU Basic Novice Ice Dance

**The Skaters don't need to meet the age requirements of Rule 108.**

#### Pattern Dances

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2014, Rules 707, 708 and all pertinent ISU Communications.

Two (2) Pattern Dances are to be skated:

**#1 Fourteenstep** and **#4 European Waltz**

Rhythms, required elements and guidelines are those listed in ISU Communications 1932 and 1947 and subsequent updates.

Couples **shall** provide their own music for the European Waltz

#### Free Dance

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2014, Rule 710 and all pertinent ISU Communications.

The required elements to be performed are those listed in ISU Communications 1932 and 1947 and subsequent updates.

Duration: 2 min., 30 sec., +/- 10 sec.

### **3. ENTRIES**

**All Entries of competitors, team leaders, coaches, chaperons and other persons must be made by the ISU Members and must reach the following address on October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2015 at latest.**

**One copy of the entry form is to be sent to the Organizing Committee.**

With the entry forms, the “Program Content Sheet” must be returned to the Organizing Committee in time. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet must be filled in precisely by each couple. The English language and the element terminology listed in the respective ISU Communications must be used.

**It is not permitted to hand over the Program Content Sheets directly to the acting Officials.**

### **ENTRY FEE**

**The entry fees for all entries are as follows:**

**€ 70,00 per couple.**

**In case no judge has been entered by the respective Member Federation the entry fees for a couple amount to € 100,00.**

**Entry fee have to be paid before the competition by bank transfer to the organizing committee.**

**After deadline of entries there is no pay back of entry fee's!**

**Entries will not be accepted, if the Entry Fee has not arrived at the Organizers account in time.**

### **4. ENTRIES OF JUDGES**

Each participating ISU Member has the right to nominate one Judge with the qualification of at least International/ISU Championships Judge for the event.

Entries of judges should reach the organizing committee not later than **October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2015.**

### **5. MEALS, LODGING and TRAVEL EXPENSES**

The Organizer will cover the expenses for provided rooms and meals for the invited Officials and for one judge from each participating country beginning with dinner on Friday November, 20<sup>th</sup> until breakfast on Monday November 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2015. Travel expenses will not be reimbursed to the Judges. Travel expenses will be paid only to the invited Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialists and Data and Replay Operators, based on the economy fare.

All Competitors, Coaches and Team Leaders have to bear their own expenses.

### **6. RESULTS**

Results in all categories will be calculated in accordance with ISU Regulations 2014, Rules 352 and 353.

## 7. MUSIC

All competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on either CD (Compact Discs) format or any other electronic means. The discs must show the exact running time of the music (not skating time), which shall be certified by the competitor and by the coach, when submitted at the time of registration. Each program must be recorded on a separate disk. Competitors must provide a back-up drive for each program.

The titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating Program for Singles and Pairs, for the Short and Free Dance Program for Ice Dance and for the Exhibition, must be listed for each Competitor on the official Music Selection Form and attached to the official Entry Form for Competitors.

**If the music information is not complete and discs are not provided, the accreditation will not be given.**

## 8. ARRIVAL OF PARTICIPANTS

All judges, competitors, team leaders, coaches, chaperons and other persons taking part in the competition are requested to register with the Organizing Committee as soon as possible but not later than on October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2015. The official "Travel form", giving the dates and times of arrival in Olomouc, should be used.

Recommended ways of travelling:

By train from Prague (the International Vaclav Havel Airport Prague) to Olomouc.

By train from the nearest airports of Ostrava (Leoš Janáček Airport, the former Mošnov Airport) and Brno to Olomouc (the distance of 70, respectively 80 kilometres to cover).

The Organizer can provide the teams with the transport from Olomouc hl.n. (the Main Railway Station) to the Flora Hotel and back. Will you send, please, together with your entry also the information whether you will be using the transportation offered. Please accept that we have to ask for a transportation fee for all persons participating in this transport service (the payment for the transportation will be made only in cash at the accreditation).

The Opening Ceremony and Opening Draws will be held at the Flora Hotel.

## **11. JUDGES MEETING**

The first judges meeting will be **at the Hotel Flora on Friday, November 20<sup>th</sup>, 2015 at 16:00 hours**. The Round Table Discussions are scheduled for Sunday, November 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2015 after the competition.

## **12. PRACTICE**

Official practices for Competitors begin on Friday, November, 20<sup>th</sup>, 2015 after the Opening Ceremony. The detailed schedule will be issued at the time of the registration. All the practices will be realized in groups as drawn.

## **13. AWARDS**

The couples placed in the first three places in each category will obtain cups; all the participants will be presented with diplomas.

## **14. VICTORY CEREMONY AND EXHIBITION**

All the participants will be invited to the ice during the final Victory Ceremony.

The couples placed in the first three places in each category will be invited to participate in the final Gala Exhibition. Additional couples may be asked to participate. (This Gala Exhibition performance should be a special program/short dance/free dance.)

## **15. INSURANCE / LIABILITY**

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in ISU Events, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.
